General Rules for Open Burning:

- Burning location must be 500 or more feet from the nearest occupied dwelling not located on the property.
- Burning can not create a traffic hazard of any kind.
- Burning can not begin or add to an existing fire before 0800.
- Nothing can be added to an existing fire after 1500.
- Burning can not take place if:
 - ⇒ Red Flag Warnings are issued.
 - ⇒ Drought Emergency exists.
 - ⇒ Common Sense issues, such as high winds, etc.
- Someone MUST be in attendance at all times.
- Must have the means to extinguish the fire should it become necessary:
 - ⇒ Water hoses.
 - ⇒ Shovels, rakes, brooms, etc.
 - ⇒ Heavy earth moving equipment for larger fires.
